

Where to buy tickets

You can buy tickets on board, in ticket machines, in kiosks and service points or through the RuterBillett app. Also you can use a travel card. More information is available here:

“How the ticket works

Single tickets apply for one journey with transfers.

A single ticket for one zone is valid for 60 minutes upon activation. It is valid for a further 30 minutes for each extra zone you buy a ticket for.

You may transfer to other means of transport (free transfer) in those zones for which the ticket applies, as long as the ticket remains valid when you get onboard.

The ticket may be used on Ruter's buses, trams, metro lines and ferries, and on NSB's trains in Oslo and Akershus.

You may have the single ticket in the RuterBillett app on mobile or on a travelcard.”
